

MONTHLY CLEAN UP 2008

HOURS: 7:30 A.M. UNTIL 2:30 P.M.

At Township Convenience Center (You bring material to our site)

1. Need a permit to get in --- FREE
2. Special permit needed for tires. \$2.00 fee for car tires, \$10.00 fee for truck or tractor tires.
3. Permit for units with Freon in them. A \$10.00 fee for each.

Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Freezers & Refrigerators

Doors must be removed before they are brought to Center!!

***ALL OPEN VEHICLES MUST BE COVERED WITH A TARP UPON ENTERING THE CONVENIENCE CENTER. (STRICTLY ENFORCED!!)**

***NO VEHICLE LARGER THAN A PICK UP TRUCK WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER**

***NO CONTRACTORS OR CONTRACTORS GENERATED MATERIAL ACCEPTED**

***NO MORE THAN 2 PICK UP TRUCK LOADS PER CLEAN UP DATE**

ITEMS ACCEPTABLE-BULKY ITEMS

Limbs, Brush and Leaves – must be separated (only 2 pick up loads per clean up date)

Metal – Washers, Dryers, Range's, Pipe, Bicycles, or any other metal products.

Swimming Pools, Liners, Furniture, Small Boats (must have motors, fuel tanks removed)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Cardboard/Newspaper, Propane/Gas Tanks, Glass, Plastic Bottles

Absolutely no Chemicals or Liquids of any kind. (Latex or Oil Base Paints)

Absolutely no Asbestos material!

Cardboard is recycled at the Senior Center- in blue Dumpster

IF ANY OF THESE ITEMS ARE FOUND UPON INSPECTION, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE SITE

CLEAN-UP DATES

MUST have a Dump Permit from the Municipal Building before entering the Convenience Site.

Convenience Center will be open the 2nd Saturday of each Month.

CHRISTMAS TREES WILL BE PICKED UP THE WEEK OF 1-14-2008

BRUSH PICK UP

- Brush must be out on the following dates. If the Road Dept. goes by and it is not out they will not return until the next pick-up date.
- Brush must be cut in 6 foot lengths. Small branches or twigs must be put in a container no larger than 30 gallon that can be picked up and dumped.
- Brush from lot clearing will not be picked up. (no more that 5 cubic yards will be picked up per household)
- **DO NOT** put bush out more than 1 week before any of the following pick up dates:
March 17, 2008; May 19, 2008; June 23, 2008; September 15, 2008; October 20, 2008

YOU CAN BRING BRUSH & LEAVES TO THE CLEAN-UP SITE ON ANY OF THE DATES THAT THE CONVENIENCE CENTER IS OPEN.

LEAF PICK UP

All leaves must be out by the day of collection for your area. If Road Department goes by and they are not out, THEY WILL NOT BE BACK!!!!!!!!!!!!

- Leaves must be piled at edge of road or pavement and no wider that 4 feet.
- Do not put leaves in fenced in area, around mail boxes, paper boxes or on hills at edge of road.
- **NO DIRT, STONES, TRASH, BRUSH, OR OTHER DEBRIS CAN BE MIXED IN OR ON LEAVES.**
- Do not rake leaves or more than 1 week before pick up date.

ZONE #1 ----- April 7, 2008

Port Norris – Mauricetown – Haleyville – Buckshutem Rd, South of
Spring Garden and Ackley Rd.

ZONE #2 ----- April 14, 2007

The Manor including Spring Garden Rd.

ZONE #3 ----- APRIL 21, 2008

From Buckshutem Rd to and including Opal Rd.

ZONE # 4 ----- April 28, 2008

West of Opal Rd to Iris Rd.

ZONE #5 ----- May 5, 2008

West of Iris Rd to Sandalwood Rd off of Doris Dr

ZONE #6 ----- May 12, 2008

All roads above the Laurel Lake Fire Hall to Point Breeze

PICK-UP DATES – FALL

ZONE # 1 ----- November 10, 2008

Port Norris – Mauricetown – Haleyville – Buckshutem Rd, South of
Spring garden and Ackley road

ZONE # 2 ----- November 17, 2008

The Manor including Spring Garden Rd.

ZONE # 3 ----- November 24, 2008

From Buckshutem Rd to and including Opal Rd.

ZONE # 4 ----- December 1, 2008

West of Opal Rd to Iris Rd

ZONE #5 ----- December 8, 2008

West of Iris Rd to Sandalwood Dr off of Doris Dr

ZONE #6 ----- December 15, 2008

All roads above Laurel Lake Fire Hall to Point Breeze

YARD CLEAN-UP WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

IF ZONING OFFICER GIVES YOU A NOTICE, AND THERE IS NO CONVENIENCE CENTER DATES WITHIN YOUR COMPLIANCE TIME, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE YOUR TRASH TO THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY LANDFILL AND PAY.
